

KIMBERLY GUSTO MEMORIAL AWARD

This Award was established in 1994 to perpetuate the memory of Kim Gusto, a Westgate graduate and valedictorian of 1987 who, along with her mother, passed away suddenly on May 30, 1993. She made her presence known in many aspects of school life, most notably through scholastic achievement and involvement in music, sports and leadership.

This \$500 award is intended to recognize a student who, like Kim, is well-rounded and demonstrates:

- ✓ Academic excellence (minimum A average)
- ✓ Outstanding personal character and leadership
- ✓ Extra-curricular involvement (sports, music, church, etc.)

Eligibility: This award is intended for a graduating student who has attended Westgate for at least 3 years and meets the criteria stated above. The candidate must be continuing his or her education next year at the university or college level.

Selection: Completed applications will be reviewed by the Awards Committee and a selection will be made after consultation with the family. The award will be presented to the recipient at the Awards Chapel.

Requirements: To apply you must:

1. Fill out the application form on the reverse side, being sure to include a summary of personal achievement and reasons why you feel you are eligible for this award.
2. Support your nomination with one reference from a staff member, a fellow student, or someone else who knows of your achievements.
